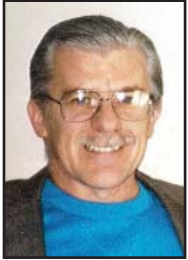

# Welcome Home, Tom Hale!

A Michigander most of his life, Tom Hale was born in Union City, New Jersey. He graduated from St. Clair High School, attended Michigan State University for one year, and then received a BS degree from the Art Center School in Los Angeles, California. Employed as a style designer at GM, Chrysler and American Motors,

Tom decided, in 1985, to earn his living exclusively with his artwork. The recipient of numerous awards, Tom has completed more than 3,100 original works that may be found in corporate, private and individual collections. His extensive list of clients includes major corporations as well as individuals who reside in no less than twelve countries throughout the world.

The recipient of more than 350 awards, he considers the most significant tribute the Gold Medal of Honor from New York City's American Watercolor Society for his artwork titled "Chrome". He was honored to be elected to the Hall of Fame in the Auburn Cord Duesenberg Museum in Auburn, Indiana. Tom has been the juror of numerous art competitions and has been invited to critique the art of various clubs and organizations.

Tom noted: "I was drawing automobiles at seven years old and have simply never stopped. I study intently the surfaces of a particular automobile trying to understand the reflective patterns and "why" ... light reacts the way it does on an automobile. [I can] ... use that surface as my canvas and attempt to create a work of art depicting what I see and imagine. I find automobiles, especially the classics and that wonderful era of the 50's, to be intriguing subjects for a work of art."

The St. Clair Art Association is pleased to welcome home this distinguished gentleman by exhibiting his incredibly beautiful works in the Alice W. Moore Center for the Arts – and to present Tom as the Featured Artist of the 38th Annual St. Clair Art Fair.

Tom's works may be found at selected art exhibits throughout the country, Concours d'Elegance events and various other automotive events. His studio in Farmington Hills is open by appointment.

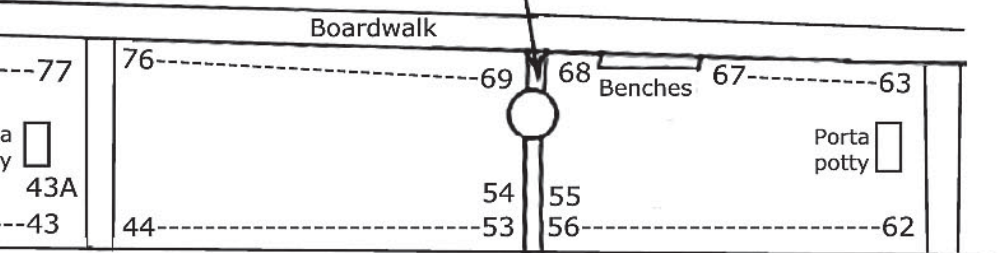
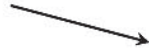

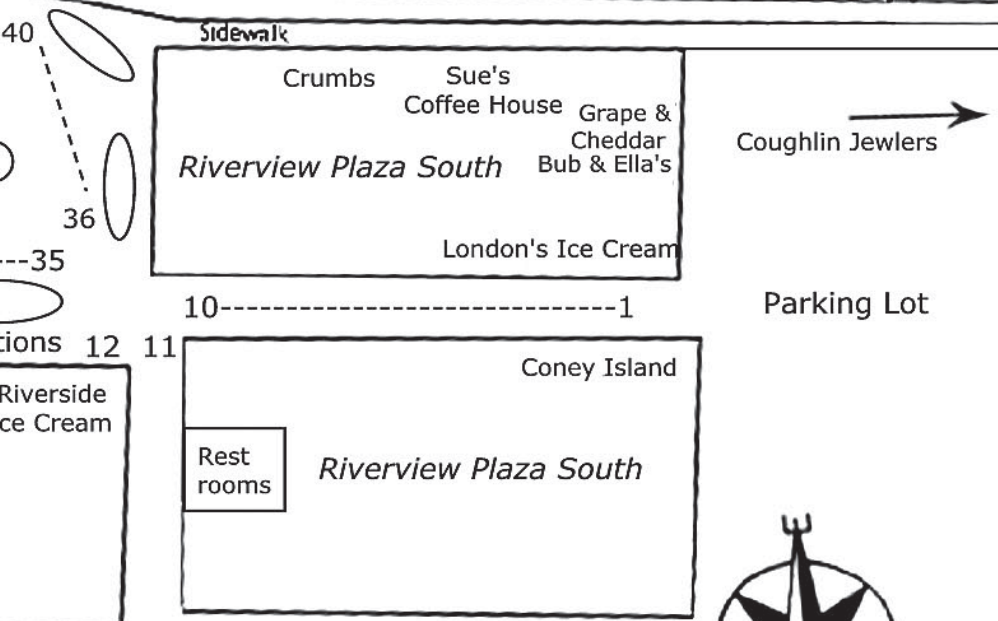

## BANNERS

The colorful display of hand-painted 8-foot lamppost banners has created a warm and cheerful atmosphere throughout St. Clair. Over two years, the competition has involved artists aged 10 years to senior citizen status. This year visitors and residents will be able to enjoy both summer and winter themes.

## SEASONS IN ST. CLAIR Art Competition

In a cooperative project with the Downtown Development Authority,



SCAA invites artists to submit an artwork depicting Fall in St. Clair. The first place awardee will receive \$1,000, a solo exhibition and a booth in the 39th SC Art Fair.
